- ✓ About one-third of all people living with HIV/AIDS in the United States are aged 50 or older
- ✓ That number is expected to grow to one-half by 2015
- ✓ New HIV diagnoses are rising among older adults
- ✓ African-American women account for 11% of women over 50 but consist of about 65% of all HIV infections among older women
